Minutes of previous meeting: Approved

Ice Bowl:

1. Hasta Tom, Katie, Altoff, and Shane are bringing chili; and Jay Greenwood is bringing cornbread
2. Merchandise is in- Corey needs a check from Jay.
3. 2 baskets will be given out for most food brought.
4. City is going to shovel and de-ice the tee pads
5. 2 portable baskets are needed for temp holes.
6. Money raised is going to be used for new basket locks.
7. Disc golf was mentioned in the Winter Games commercial, however the event is not part of the Winter Games; Corey is going to talk to the guy in charge to see if we are an affiliate event.
8. Cost for all Ice Bowl items was \$781.40.

Club Memberships:

1. Last year dues were \$15
 - a. New dues? – minimum \$20 and you get a disc, number, and bag tag – Joe is still looking into numbers.
2. The Club is looking into Online sign-up; it would cost \$113.
3. Corey thinks we should give league numbers that member keeps (like PDGA #).
4. Getting new discs this year? Chris suggested coming up with a new stamp, Corey thinks we should keep the stamp because it would be cheaper to have them run because they already have stamp.
5. Jay moved that Joe crunches numbers and get back to us next month, Corey seconded, voted unanimous yes.

Storage Unit:

1. We are still at budget storage, but in a different unit.
2. Right now our current unit is not big enough, but if we get the new course installed the current unit would be sufficient as the 18 baskets would be removed.
3. Chris will check into finding a cheaper storage location, currently we pay \$55 per month.
4. We are missing 1 fly pad, so we currently have 16.

Club PDGA Affiliate:

1. We will have affiliate PDGA sign-ups @ Ice Bowl.
 - a. Players signing-up through the club receive a \$5 discount.
2. All board members should take the test Officials test as it is free with the affiliate program.

Big Creek:

1. The proposed sign to be put up throughout Big Creek has been submitted to the Ski Club and Kim with Big Creek Park.
 - a. Working with them on the sign is progress towards a healthy relationship with the Ski Club; this will allow both parties to enjoy the park during the winter months.
2. If DNR approves the sign they will post them for us.

Challenge:

1. First Class Credit Union is still the Title Sponsor; Michael Anderson has left FCCU, Joe Ackers is the new marketing director for FCCU.
2. Working with Joe on landing KGGO as a sponsor/media outlet.
3. Tournament Staff – Corey Philips is the Head TD, Joe Wiley is the Assistant TD, Course Manager is Tyler Sarg, Financial Manager is Jay Greenwood, Scoring Manager is Brian Gunnink, Volunteer Manager is Chris Greenleaf, Publicity Manager is Jason Williamson, Sponsor/Marketing Manager is Corey Philips.
4. Schedule is complete and turned into PDGA.
5. Web-site expires soon, Corey needs check to re-new it; Joe moved to pay, Jay seconded, voted unanimous yes.
6. Chris is going to get in contact with the person to getting a stage for awards.
7. Corey is still working on getting lunches for players every day, Chris wants all the volunteers to receive players packs and lunch.
8. Damon Culver is going to help out with the marketing.
9. Challenge meeting are once a month for now, closer to the Challenge they will go to twice a month.

2009 Bylaws:

1. Take copy of bylaws and look them over, next meeting bring back any edits we would like.
2. We need to change the number of positions on the board.
 - a. Joe is going to bring a list of responsibilities for each member.

Kids Fest:
