DMDGC Business Cards:

1. Corey has the design done and test printed them.
 - a. The paper / template used yielded poor results.
2. Corey should have the cards at the next meeting.

By-Laws:

1. The committee hasn't had a chance to meet yet, but they will have it done for next meeting.

Club Memberships:

1. Joe decided not to do the Club Champion program.
2. Joe needs \$100 to get the bag tags; Corey moved to give him the money, Tyler seconded, voted yes.

Basket Locks:

J&B Rolling Hills Disc Golf Course Maintenance Work Day:
