

## **DES MOINES DISC GOLF CLUB MEETING**

### **DMDGCG League / Membership Update:**

1. League has been going well.
2. Club memberships have been going slow.
3. Joe deposited \$1127.00 from league.
4. There are no league flyers at Ewing or Walnut Ridge; we need to get them posted.

### **Basket Locks:**

1. The order has been placed, but we haven't received them yet.
2. When we get them we will start replacing locks one course at a time.
3. Certain baskets should be moved to let the area around the baskets recover.

### **Walnut Ridge Retro Memorial:**

1. May 24<sup>th</sup> is the day of the tournament.
2. Tyler and Jay are the TD's and have it sanctioned the event with the PDGA; C-Tier.
3. Jay has 10 baskets lined up for the retro layout and possible temp holes.
  - a. Jay is going to e-mail volunteers with a list of holes and where their basket needs to be placed.
4. First round is going to be in the old layout second round will be the current layout.
5. Jay sent e-mail to Becky to let her know about the tournament.
  - a. Becky will be notifying the old school disc golfers of Des Moines.
6. Jay expects the tournament to fill up soon.
7. Jay says he could use help between the rounds removing baskets and at the end cleaning up the course.
8. Tyler is going to have a maintenance night at Walnut Ridge to get some of the old holes cleaned up.
9. Jay brought up the idea of buying hamburgers, brats, chips, and soda and have someone cook them and sell them as a fundraiser for the Club.
  - a. Another idea is to pre-order subs from Subway for people who want subs for lunch.

### **Polk City 4 Season's Festival Update:**

1. Joe has been in contact with the Polk City festival about helping them run a tournament.
  - a. The tournament is to be held the weekend after the Challenge @ Big Creek.
2. Chris, Jay, and Jason have volunteered to help Joe run the event.
3. Joe will get more details and report back to volunteers and the Club.

**Challenge Update:**

1. Corey is working on Sponsorships with Damon Culver
  - a. Wal-Mart – Final 9 Sponsor - \$1000
  - b. Beer Crazy – Tee Sponsor
  - c. Vitamin Water contacted Corey through the PDGA about sponsoring the event.
    - i. Corey in contact with Teresa with Vitamin Water
  - d. Citadel Network (KGGO) has backed out of media sponsorship; conflicting events
  - e. Damon is working on Frito-Lays and Pepsi
  - f. Jason Williamson is trying to work with Scheel's sponsor thru CFR disc sales.
2. Course Work is a high priority; schedule should be increased to 2 days a week when possible.
3. We need to push Challenge sign-up more at league
  - a. The registration deadline is 2 weeks before tournament
4. Chris is continuously compiling a list of volunteers; please send interested people his way.

**Disc Golf Course Maintenance Day:**

1. Grandview now has two retaining walls in front of the tees on #1 and #10
2. There are 3 or 4 tee signs that aren't up at Walnut Ridge, the core will pay for cost for replacement tee signs; couple of posts at Walnut Ridge are also missing.
3. Tyler has compiled a detailed list of what needs to be done at each course.

**Mac Rae Park Update:**

1. Chris has had people willing to pay for a tee signs; with tee sponsorship
2. Corey has no new updates
3. When approved the goal is for a sprig opening; at the same time we don't want to rush the project.

**Principal Classic:**

1. On Tuesday May 26<sup>th</sup>, Clue is running the Principal Charity Classic disc golf event at Southwoods
2. A clinic will be held at 11:00am with the first session starting at 12:00pm
  - a. The event will be 2 9 hole sessions
3. The scope of the event is to get young professionals to come out to the Principal Charity Classic golf event; the disc golf event will be used to bring them to the event.
4. They will let us have a booth there if we would like to Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
  - a. The Club has decided against this as time for the Challenge is already scarce; prepping for this is event could be very time consuming.

**Miscellaneous:**

1. Iowa Tour Review
  - a. Shane says its going good, but communication errors with Chase has created a hiccup in tracking who is in the tour.
    - i. That makes it a little harder to track points at the beginning
  - b. Neils Johnson is going to help Shane with tracking points
  - c. Shane will get point leaders as best he can for next meeting, it won't be completely accurate at first due the clerical error.
1. Shane and Corey have discussed charging a rental fee for the use of our fly pads; the amount would depend on delivery distance from Des Moines and how many pads they are renting.
2. The By-laws changes have been posted on the Club Website.
3. Corey has Club business cards, but not on him, e-mail Corey if you want some and the amount needed.
